

Dear Sir,

Please find below the requirement of documents for Opening of NRI Account with the **attestation of banker** on each document as mentioned below. **(2 Sets of Document)**

- Passport size Colour photograph of Applicant & Signature with BLACK Pen (For Scanning)
- Across signed on photograph.
- Copy of RBI approval letter (primary bank are also allowed). **(attestation of banker)**
- A copy of Passport and Visa duly attested by the client. [In the case of an NRI A/c without repatriation, proof of Indian address has to be given.] **(attestation of banker)**
- Copy of Indian Address proof. **(attestation of banker)**
- Copy of Foreign Address proof. **(attestation of banker)**
- Copy of Bank Statement and cancelled cheque copy. **(attestation of banker)**
- Copy of PIS NRE or NRO form according to the NRE or NRO. **(attestation of banker)**
- Copy of PAN Card. **(attestation of banker)**
- If NRI Client given POA then POA letter to whom power is given for signature & trading behalf of the client (certified true copy) & Personal details of POA Authorised person. **(attestation of banker)**
- Sign on back page of trading form on Process Flow.

Note:

Photocopies of the above documents, if accepted, should be attested by the Indian Embassy / Consulate General / Notary Public / Any Court / Magistrate / Judge / **Local Banker** in the country where the NRI resides. The attesting authority should affix a "verified with originals" stamp on the said documents. The photocopies of the KYC documents and PAN card should also be signed by the NRI.

- **If the NRI comes in person to open the account, the above attestation requirement may be waived.**
